FROM NORMAL TO LOCK-DOWN IN THE BLINK OF AN EYE!

Less than a week after PAGA's last Board of Trustees meeting on March, 11, Metro Manila, and soon thereafter, all of Luzon, was under quarantine to minimize the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes the COVID-19 disease.

Since the quarantine effectively shuttered all "non-essential" businesses, almost all of our PAGA beneficiaries' families suffered a partial or total loss of income and the resulting financial stress, and in some cases, hunger.

In order to help our beneficiaries, given the urgent circumstances, our social workers interviewed and assessed all of them. They determined that 64 families were in immediate need, and we provided cash remittances to these families in March, and again in April. Our intention is to augment, not replace, what they may already receive in cash or relief goods from the local barangay, LGU, DSWD, or DOLE.

Two long months later we are awaiting the decision by the IATF and the President about moving from ECQ to GCQ, a somewhat lower, but still intrusive, set of restrictions.

Our social workers will continue to review the status of our beneficiaries' families again in mid-May and we will respond accordingly.

Meanwhile, our staff and Board of Trustees will be working through changes required for us to continue delivering PAGA's programs and services in the GCQ era, and beyond.
