



## Webinars for PAGA Student Beneficiaries

For almost 2 years now traditional classroom instruction has been prohibited and replaced with a “blended” learning system whereby students study online classes from home and answer printed lesson modules.

Adjustment for the students has been stressful and the results have been mixed, at best. PAGA social workers have guided them to practice positive coping strategies.

Recently, PAGA conducted a series of webinars for beneficiaries with the theme: *“PAGA Cares - Kamustahan, Students Life Learning Experiences during the COVID-19 Pandemic.”*

These webinars provided a venue for interaction with their co-beneficiaries via Zoom teleconferencing since no face-to-face PAGA activities are yet allowed.

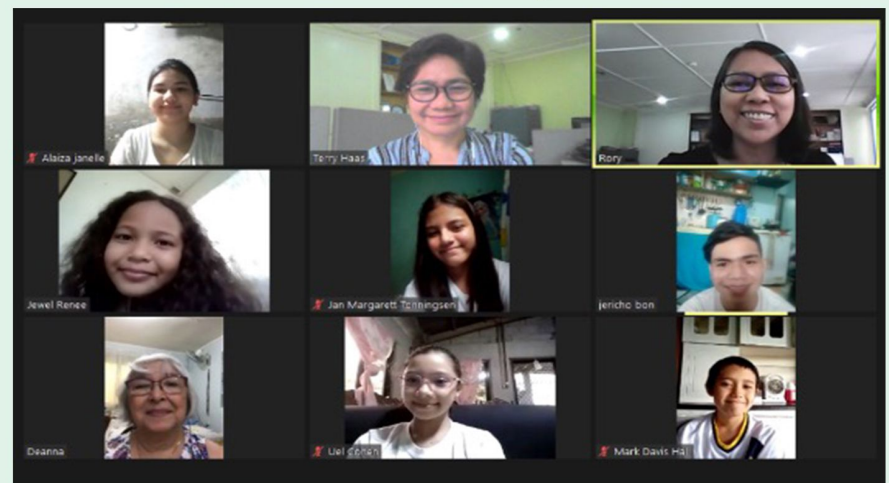
From their sharing:

- o Most encountered difficulties with distance learning but still moved up to the next educational level.
- o Many have mentioned gaining new friends online, and have developed self-confidence and knowledge of using different applications such as Google Meet, Zoom, and Microsoft Office.
- o Most students feel that classroom learning is better than the current online and modular classes.

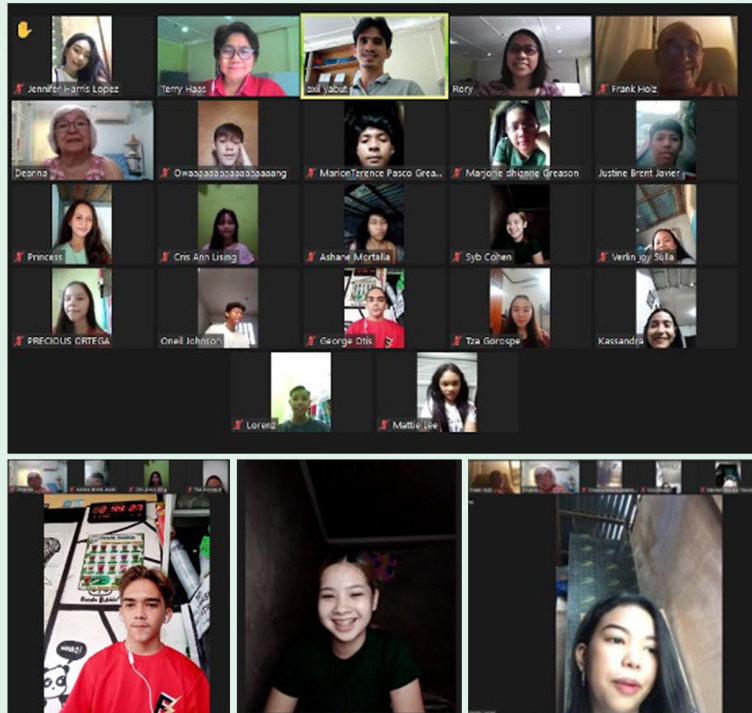

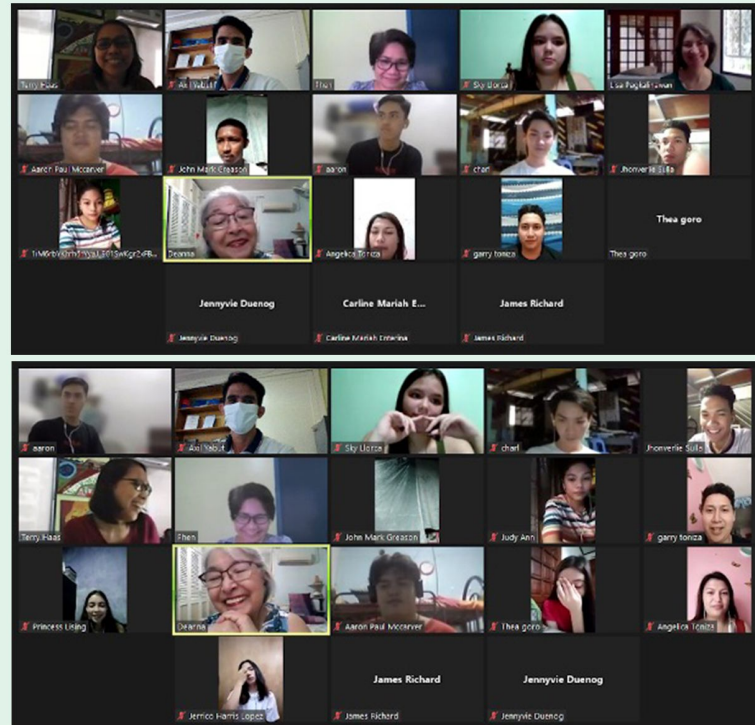

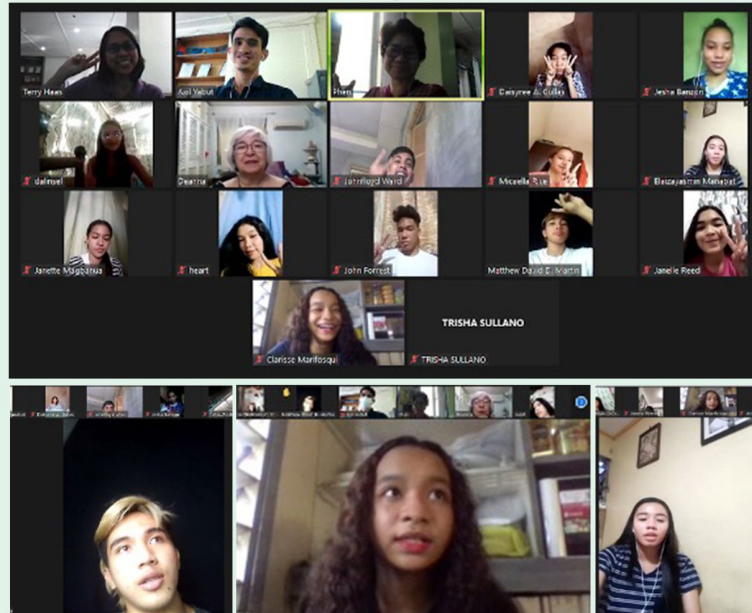
## Junior High School

## Senior High School

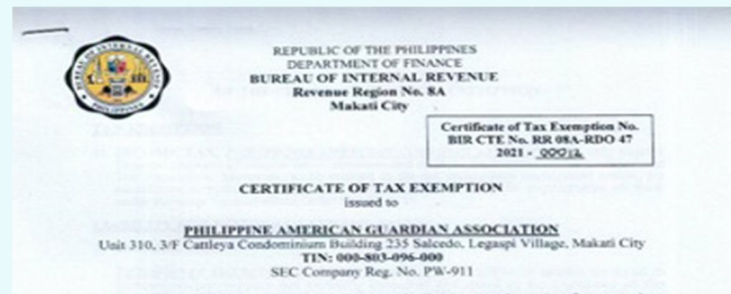
